

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DEFINITIONS







Assembly And Installation

Installation to FPIWMKIT mount

 Hang macro height-adjustment brackets (D) onto FPIWMKIT upper rail lip on bracket. (See Figure 1)



NOTE: If installing below, disassemble macro height-adjustment brackets (D) and reassemble by rotating attachment section of bracket. (See Figure 2)



2. Use two #10-24 x 3/8" button head cap screws (FA) to secure horizontal adjustment bracket (B) to two macro height-adjustment brackets (D). (See Figure 3)



3. Tighten screws at bottom of macro height-adjustment brackets (D) to secure brackets to lower rails. (See Figure 4)



 Use two 1/4-20 x 1/2" Phillips flathead cap screws (FB) to secure camera shelf (A) to micro height-adjustment bracket (E). (See Figure 5)

NOTE: If adapter bracket (C) is required to mount camera, attach adapter bracket at this point rather than camera shelf. See Step 5 for details.



 (Adapter bracket ONLY) Use two 1/4-20 x 1/2" Phillips flat head screws (FB) to secure adapter bracket (C) to micro height-adjustment bracket (E). (See Figure 6)



- Loosely install two #10-24 x 3/8" button head cap screws (FA) into lower holes on center of horizontal adjustment bracket (B). (See Figure 7)
- 7. Hang micro height adjustment bracket (E) onto two partially installed screws (FA). (See Figure 7)



- Move shelf vertically to desired mounting height. (See Figure 8)
- Tighten screws to secure camera shelf at desired mounting height. (See Figure 8)
- Install two additional #10-24 x 3/8" button head cap screws (FA) to secure micro height-adjustment bracket to horizontal bracket (B). (See Figure 8)



NOTE: If desired mounting height is a location where screws are aligned with keyhole locations, use universal washers (FD) to secure shelf in position. (See Figure 9)



11. (Optional) Apply adhesive foam pads (FC) to back of micro height-adjustment bracket (E) as desired. (See Figure 10)



Camera Installation

 Use 1/4-20 x 1/2" button head cap screw (FE) or hardware supplied with camera to secure camera from bottom to camera shelf (A). (See Figure 11)



 (Using Adapter) Use hardware included with camera to attach camera to camera adapter (C). (See Figure 12)



Adjustments

Micro Height-adjustment

- Loosen screws on micro height-adjustment bracket. (See Figure 13)
- 2. Adjust to desired height. (See Figure 13)
- Tighten screws on micro height-adjustment bracket. (See Figure 13)



Macro Height-adjustment

- Loosen screws on macro height-adjustment brackets. (See Figure 13)
- 5. Adjust to desired height. (See Figure 13)
- Tighten screws on macro height-adjustment brackets. (See Figure 13)

Cable Management




Figure 14



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

 Use cable ties (not included) to secure cables as desired to mount utilizing tabs on brackets. (See Figure 14)
