

## **Portable Electric Grill**

OWNER'S MANUAL ASSEMBLY AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS **READ BEFORE OPERATING GRILL** 



• For Outdoor Use Only (outside any enclosure). Do not use indoors for commercial cooking. Fuel such as charcoal briquettes, are not to be used with this appliance. The supply cord should be regularly examined for signs of damage and the appliance is not to be used if cord is damaged.

• To ensure continued protection against risk of electric shock, connect to properly grounded three prong GFI outlets only. Do not use a two prong adapter.


• Use only outdoors, do not expose to rain. This is to prevent electric shock which can cause serious bodily injury or death.

• Disconnect appliance from supply circuit before performing maintenance and cleaning.

• For protection against risk of electric shock, connect to properly grounded outlets only.

• For protection against risk of electric shock, keep extension cord connection dry and off the ground.

• Store Temperature Controller Indoors when not in use.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

#### DANGER

Failure to follow the Dangers, Warnings and Cautions contained in this Owner's Manual may result in serious bodily injury or death, or in fire or an explosion causing damage to property.

- Do not clean with metal scouring pads. Pieces can break off the pad and touch electrical parts, creating a risk of electric shook.
- Do not use charcoal in this appliance.
- Do not touch surfaces that may be hot. Use handles or knobs provided.
- To protect against electrical shock Do not immerse cord, plugs, portable appliances (or other specific part or parts) in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Make sure appliance is OFF and remove plug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning. Allow to cool before handling.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or is dropped or damaged in any manner. For any assistance or replacement parts call our consumer service department at 1-866-994-6390 or email at grilling@thefulhamgroup.com.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch hot surfaces.
- Where applicable, always attach plug to appliance and check that the control is OFF before plugging cord into wall outlet. To disconnect, turn the control to OFF, then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Avoid contacting moving parts.
- Fuel, such as charcoal briquettes, is not to be used with appliance.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- USE ONLY AUONE, TYPE TKSP-S004 TEMPERATURE CONTROLLING PLUG.
- For outdoor household use only.

## A WARNING:

Do not use charcoal or other combustible fuels in this grill. This grill is not designed for charcoal use and a fire could result. The fire could create an unsafe condition and damage to the grill.

- Always plug Temperature Controller into grill before plugging power cord into outlet.
- Do not operate unit if plug receptacle is damaged.
- Operate grill only on a level, stable surface.
- Do not in any way alter this product or its use.
- If using an extension cord it must be rated no less than that of the appliance. Extension cords must be marked with the letter "W" and with a tag stating, "Suitable for use with outdoor appliance".
- Use shortest length extension cord possible. Do not connect 2 or more extension cords together.
- Do not immerse grill or Temperature Controller in water when cleaning.
- Do not leave Temperature Controller in the ON position during periods of non-use.
- Do not leave grill unattended when in use.
- Keep children and pets away from grill when in use.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons unless they have been adequately supervised by a responsible person to ensure that they can use the appliance safely.
- Clean drip tray regularly.
- Locate power cord away from traffic areas. Arrange the cord so that it will not be pulled or tripped over.
- Do not use grill near combustible materials such as dry grass, shrubs, etc.
- Do not allow grill to come into close contact with flammable materials such as paper, walls, draperies, towels, chemicals, etc.
- Do not use as a heater.
- Do not move the grill while it is in use. Allow the appliance to cool before moving, cleaning or storing it.
- Do not use grill when raining or snowing.

- To prevent grill from being splashed or falling into water, do not set grill within 10 feet of any body of water such as a pool or pond.
- Do not operate grill with a Temperature Controller that has a damaged cord or plug. Call The Fulham Group for a replacement Temperature Controller. The Temperature Controller is made specifically for this grill.
- Pulling Temperature Controller by the knob could cause the knob to come off.
- Do not allow cord to touch the grill when it is hot.
- This grill is intended for outdoor household use only. Do not use indoors or for commercial cooking.
- If a flare up occurs, do not use water to put out fire. Turn grill to OFF. Unplug power cord and wait for grill to cool.
- Make sure no other high wattage appliances are plugged into the same circuit when using grill.
- Do not clean this product with a water spray or the like.
- Unplug grill when not in use and cover when cool. Properly store the appliance indoors when not in use – out of the reach of children.
- Use this grill only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended in this manual may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Always ensure that electrical socket being used has the correct rating. Socket must be rated no less than 120V AC, 13Amps.
- This appliance conforms to technical standards and the safety requirements for electrical devices.
- The drip tray must be in place at all times during grill operation.
- Do not build this model of grill in any built-in or slide-in construction. Ignoring this warning could cause a fire or an explosion that may damage property or cause serious bodily injury or death.



## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

Before beginning assembly, installation or operation of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and diagram above. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product. Contact customer service for replacement parts.

#### STEP 1


• Wash grill base, grill tray and lid with warm and dish soap. Rinse and dry thoroughly.

**Note:** Do not immerse temperature control probe in water or any other liquid. To clean, wipe with a damp

cloth and dry thoroughly.


#### STEP 2

 Place pedestal base on a flat surface. Insert slotted end of pedestal tube into center hole of pedestal base and push down firmly.




# STEP 3

 Place grill base on top of pedestal tube assembly, ensuring hole on center of grill based engages with tube.



#### STEP 4


• Place grease tray securely into position inside grill base. When properly placed, it is held firmly with pointed end in center of grill base.





#### **STEP 5**

• Position grill plate securely on grill base.




• Position probe receptacle through probe cutout in top side of grill base.



#### STEP 7

• Attach lid handle to lid from the inside using rubber-ringed fastener/hook.


**Note:** When operating the air vent in the lid handle, avoid excessive force that can damage the handle or lid.

## WARNINGS

## WARNING:

• Any modification of the appliance may be dangerous.

• Visually inspect cord, plug and Temperature Controller for damage and wear before operation.

- When heating the grill for the first time, it may give off a slight burning odor. The grill is burning off excess lubricants found on the heating element. This does not affect the safety of your grill.
- To prevent fire or electric shock, always use a certified electrician should new circuits or outlets be required.
- Improperly grouded outlets could cause electrical shock.
- The use of an extension cord is not recommended. If you must use an extension cord, use the shortest length extension cord possible. Do not connect 2 or more extension cords together. Keep connections off the ground and dry. Do not let cord hang over edge of table top where it can be tripped over or pulled by children. Only use extension cord labeled for outdoor use.

- Cover grill or store in weather protected area when not in use.
- Clean the grate and cookbox between uses.
  - Warning: Do not use the barbecue within 60 cm (24in) of combustible materials from the back or sides of the grill. Do not use under any combustible construction.
  - Warning: The entire cooking box gets hot when in use.
    Do not leave unattended.
  - Warning: Keep any electrical power cord away from any heated surface.
  - Warning: Keep the cooking area clear of inflammable vapors and liquids such as petrol, kerosene, alcohol, etc., and other combustible materials.
  - Warning: When cooking, the appliance must be on a level, stable surface in an area clear of combustible material.
  - Warning: Keep cord clear of cookbox.

## HOW TO USE

1. Turn temperature control probe to OFF position and attach securely into probe receptacle.

**2.** Plug into standard GFCI outlet. Align desired temperature setting with indicator light. Place lid securely on grill. Allow gill to preheat to desired temperature – for approximately 10 minutes.

**3.** Carefully remove lid and place food onto grill; cover for most foods. Cook until done, turning at least once halfway through cooking time for most food. Adjust temperature as needed.

**Tip:** You can control moisture of foods, to some extent, by opening or closing lid vent. Turn lid handle / vent clockwise to open vent for drier cooking. Turn counterclockwise to hold in moisture for moister meats. Light on temperature control probe will cycle on and off as grill thermostat maintains proper temperature. This is normal operation.

Note: Condensation may collect on inside of lid when cooking.

Important: Use caution when removing lid.

**4.** When finished cooking, turn temperature control probe to OFF position. Temperature probe indicator light will go out. Unplug and allow grill to cool before disassembling and cleaning. See CARE AND CLEANING.

**Note:** Temperature control probe may be turned to setting 1 to keep foods warm for short periods of time.

**Note:** To avoid damaging the non-stick surface, use only plastic or wooden utensils while cooking.

**Caution:** Grill surfaces are hot during use. Allow grill, grease tray, lid and grill base to cool completely before handling and cleaning.

## CLEANING

#### **OUTSIDE SURFACE:**

- 1. Wipe surface grime off with a clean cloth and mild dishwashing detergent or baking soda.
- **2.** For stubborn surface dirt, use warm soapy water solution and a nylon scrubbing brush.
- 3. Clean the rinse with water.
- 4. Allow surfaces to dry fully before use.

## **STORAGE AND / OR NON-USE**

- During periods of non-use, the Temperature Controller with power cord should be in the "OFF" position.
- Store grill indoors.

#### **OPERATING:**

## WARNING:

The grill must not be used upon any combustible surface such as dry grass, shrubs, etc.

## WARNING:

The grill is not intended for installation in or on recreational vehicles, SUVs and/or boats.

# WARNING:

To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse any part of this appliance in water or any other liquid.

## 9. WARRANTY and REPLACEMENT PARTS

This warranty covers defects in parts and workmanship for a period of 3 years from the original purchase date. Any damage claim regarding the enameling must be submitted within 30 days of purchase to be covered by the warranty.

#### The following conditions are NOT covered by this warranty:

- Unevenness and color variations in the enamel coating.
- Damage caused by improper assembly or disregard of the manual.
- Use of spare parts not supplied by manufacturer.
- Damage resulting from modifications or inappropriate use.
- Abuse of the grill
- Damage caused by improper maintenance or repairs by an unauthorized person.

#### Limitations and exclusions:

- 1. This warranty applies only to the original purchaser and may not be transferred.
- 2. If you can not verify the purchase date of the grill the warranty period will begin on the date the grill was manufactured.
- 3. Replacement or repair parts are warranted for the remaining period of the original part warranty.

#### Your obligations:

This grill must be assembled, installed, operated and maintained in accordance with all applicable codes and the instruction manual furnished with this grill. You must keep an invoice, cancelled check or payment record to verify the purchase date of the grill.
