Indicates that the violation of instructions may cause slight injury or damage to the product.

Safety Notes for Power and AC Adaptors

WARNING

- For power cords and AC adapters, use the proper product supplied by the manufacturer or an approved standard
 product. If you wish to use another power cord, ensure it meets the national standards. If the power cord is defective,
 contact the manufacturer or the nearest authorized service center for replacement.
- Operate it from the power source (voltage, etc.) indicated in the product specifications.
 - There is a risk of fire or electric shock due to product damage. If you are unsure of the type of power supply provided at the location you wish to install, please contact a professional equipment company.
- · Always connect the power cord to a grounded outlet.
 - It may result in electrical shock, injury, or product damage.
- Ensure that the power cord and AC adaptor are firmly plugged in so that the connection is not loose.
 - Poor connections can lead to fire or electric shock.
- In the presence of thunder and lightning, never touch the power cord and signal cable because it can be very dangerous.
 - Otherwise, this may result in electric shock.
- Take care not to place any heavy objects (electronics, clothing, etc.) on or step on the power cord or AC adaptor. In addition, do not bend or pull the power cord and AC adaptor with excessive force.
 - Damaged wires can cause fire or electric shock.
- Do not connect the power cord or AC adaptor to a socket if it has been damaged by a sharp object.
 - Otherwise, this may result in electric shock.
- Do not insert conductors (metal chopsticks, etc.) into the other socket while the power cord is connected to one side
 of the socket. In addition, do not touch the power cord immediately after it is unplugged from the socket.
 - Otherwise, this may result in electric shock.
- Do not connect multiple electrical appliances or heating devices to a multi socket. Use a dedicated multi socket with a
 ground terminal.
 - Overheating may result in a fire.

- If water or any foreign substance enters the product, disconnect the power cord immediately and contact the service center.
 - Product damage may result in fire or electric shock.
- · Keep the power cord and AC adaptor away from heating devices.
 - The casing of the wires may melt, causing fire or electric shock.
- Do not disassemble, repair or modify the power cord or AC adapter by yourself.
 - Otherwise, this may result in fire or electric shock.
- The main power disconnecting device is the power cord. The product should be installed near a socket for easy
 operation.
- If the product is connected to the AC wall power source, switching off the product will not completely cut off the AC power.
- Power consumption will be "0" only when the power cord is unplugged.
- · Use the power plug for the device as a shut-off device.

! CAUTION

- · Wipe off any dirt on the socket, power cord pins, and AC adaptors to keep them clean.
 - Overheating caused by dust layers may result in fire or electric shock.
- Wipe off any water on the socket, power cord pins, and AC adaptors to keep them clean. Do not touch the power cord or AC adaptor if your hands are wet.
 - Otherwise, this may result in electric shock.
- Do not turn the product on or off by connecting or disconnecting the power cord. In other words, do not use the power cord as a switch.
 - This may cause an electric shock or product malfunction.
- Do not remove the power cord when the product is in use.
 - Otherwise, the product may be damaged due to electrical shock.

Precautions When Moving the Product

WARNING

- Please make sure to contact the service center before moving the product.
 - Otherwise, it may result in electric shock or damage to the product.
- · Turn off the power and make sure all connected cables are disconnected before moving the product.
 - Otherwise, it may result in electric shock or damage to the product.
- · When moving the product, be careful not to apply any force and do not press the front panel.
 - Otherwise, it may result in electric shock or damage to the product.
- When moving the product, comply with the standard requirements for personnel according to weight. (25 kg (55.1 lbs)) or less per person, use a moving equipment if it exceeds 100 kg (220.4 lbs))
- It may cause personal injury or product damage. Using the product after it has been dropped may result in electric shock or fire. Contact the service center.
- Do not hold the product upside down while holding the stand alone. (Only applicable for models with a stand.)
 - It may cause damage to the product, such as stand distortion or damage to the panel.



• Do not throw away the product box. The product can be placed inside the box when moving it.

Installation Precautions

WARNING

- Please make sure to contact the service center before installing the product.
 - Otherwise, it may result in electric shock or damage to the product.
- · Do not drop or apply excessive force to the product. Keep the product out of reach of children. Do not throw toys or objects onto the product panel.
 - It may result in personal injury or damage to the product/panel.
- · Do not place heavy objects, sit, or hang on the product.
- If the product falls, it may cause personal injury.
- Do not touch the overheated surface of the product.
 - This can cause personal injury.
- · Install the product firmly fixed on a floor, wall, etc. to prepare against external impact such as wind or an earthquake.
 - Be sure to refer to the manual provided.
- Be careful not to let children climb or hang on the product.
 - If the product falls, it may cause personal injury.
- · Do not install near a heating device such as an electric stove or lighting equipment.
 - It may cause fire, electric shock, or malfunction.

! CAUTION

- Do not install the product in a place with electromagnetic interference.
- If the product is installed in a special place other than the normal conditions of use, serious problems may occur in image quality, lifespan, and appearance due to the influence of the surrounding environment. Please make sure to check with our service personnel before installation. Be careful of unwarranted conditions and places such as places where lots of fine dust is generated, places where lots of oil mist is generated, places where chemicals are used, places exposed to direct sunlight, places where the temperature is too high or too low, and places with high humidity when installing the product.
- · Place the product a minimum distance (100 mm (3.9 inches)) away from the wall to ensure good ventilation.
 - If it is installed too closely to the wall, it may cause product damage or fire due to a rise in internal temperature.
- When the power cord is connected, make sure that the vents are not blocked by tablecloths, curtains, or other objects (such as plastic).
 - It may be deformed or fire can break out due to internal heat.
- Do not install it in a place where ventilation is not available (such as a bookcase or closet), or in a separately created outside place, or on a carpet or a cushion.
 - Fire can break out due to internal heat.

Precautions When Cleaning Product



WARNING

- · Always keep the product and inside of the product clean.
 - If you do not clean the product, dust will accumulate inside and may create a fire hazard or damage to the product.
- · Contact the service center for internal cleaning of the product.
 - It may result in fire, electric shock, and damage to the product.
- · When cleaning the product, disconnect the power cord and wipe it gently with a soft cloth to prevent scratches.
- Electric shock and screen damage may occur due to scratches.
- When cleaning the frame, spray water on a soft cloth 2-4 times, then slowly wipe in one direction.
 - Too much moisture can cause staining.



! CAUTION

- · When cleaning the product or panel, disconnect the power cord and wipe it gently with a soft cloth. Do not spray water directly on the product or wipe it with a wet mop. In particular, never use any cleaners, air fresheners, mosquito repellents, lubricants, automotive and industrial polishes, abrasives, thinners, benzene, alcohol, etc. as they may damage the product or panel.
 - This may cause a fire, electric shock, or product damage (deformation, corrosion or breakage).

Precautions When Using Product



- Do not use the product in any environment that exceeds the temperature or humidity limits.
 - Otherwise, it may result in electric shock or damage to the product.
- If you are using the product for a long time, take occasional breaks to protect your eyesight.
 - Otherwise, your eyesight may be weakened.
- · Listening to the sound loudly or using it for a long time can adversely affect your hearing.
- If water or any foreign substance goes inside the product, turn off the power, unplug the power cord and contact the service center.
 - If used without taking appropriate measures, it may cause electric shock or fire.
- In the event that no image appears on the screen or no sound is heard, stop using the product. Immediately turn off
 the power, unplug the power cord and contact the service center.
 - If used without taking appropriate measures, it may cause electric shock or fire.
- Do not apply shock to the product or the screen by dropping an object onto the product.
 - It may cause personal injury, product failure, or screen damage.
- If you smell something unusual, hear a strange noise, or see smoke coming out of the device, unplug the power cord and contact the service center.
 - If used without taking appropriate measures, it may result in electric shock or fire.
- · Never disassemble, repair, or modify the product at the user's discretion. If necessary, contact the service center.
 - It may result in electric shock or fire.
- · Do not place objects filled with liquid, such as a vase or a cup on the product to allow liquid to get inside the product.
 - Otherwise, this may result in electric shock, fire, product malfunction, or deformation.
- Do not press hard on the surface of the product with your hands or scratch it with a sharp object such as nails, pencils, or pens. And do not impact the front or sides of the screen with a hard object, such as a metal object, and do not scratch the screen.

- Do not use high voltage products near the device. (electronic mosquito swatter, etc.)
- Electric shock could cause the device to malfunction.
- In the event of a gas leak, never touch the socket and open windows for ventilation.

- If the product or case is dropped and damaged, turn off the power and disconnect the power cord.


Check Before Installing the Product (User Installation Guide)

Open the drawer front.




2 Remove the back cover.

- 3 Put the screw back into the set.



Using the Touch Monitor

Touch Monitor

- The PC can be used by touching the screen as a PC input device instead of the keyboard and mouse.
- The touch screen recognizes the minute current of the human body (capacitive type), so it must be touched with the tip of the finger.



Please check before use.

- Be careful not to let electricity come into contact with the screen. Doing so may result in malfunction due to electrical stimulation, such as static electricity.
- Do not press the touch screen with your fingertip using excessive force or with a pointed object. Doing so may result in the screen becoming damaged or broken.
- The device may not work properly if you wear gloves, if your fingers are dirty, or if you touch it with your fingernails or a ballpoint pen.
- Take care as the touch sensor may not work properly if the screen is wet or has moisture.
- When using a fixed screen for an extended period of time, an after-image (screen deterioration) or smearing may occur, so the screen should be turned off when not in use.



Shutting Down the System / Turning Off the PC


The Windows shut-down option can be used in the following ways:

- Press the \blacksquare \rightarrow \bigcirc button and select [System Shut-down].
- Press the power switch button on the PC.



! CAUTION

- Switching off incorrectly may result in product failure. (Failure to power on, blue screen, performance degradation, etc.)
 - $\stackrel{\cdot}{\mathbb{X}}$ Examples of switching off incorrectly include turning off the circuit breaker, turning off the extension lead, and pulling out the power plug during operation.




THINGS TO CHECK BEFORE REPORTING A BREAKDOWN

- » Each model may have different points to check.
- » For more instructions on PC settings, please refer to Windows Help.

Issues Related to Use

- · The power won't turn on.
 - Check if the power cord is correctly plugged into the power outlet.
 - For models using an AC adaptor, disconnect the AC adaptor, clean the contact terminals, and turn the power on again.
- The 'Unknown Product' message appears when the product is connected.
 - Check if the PC (graphics card) driver is installed.
 - Check the user manual of the PC (graphics card) to see if the plug and play feature is supported.
- · The receipt printout is blurred.
 - Ensure that the printer cover is closed properly.



Issues Related to Screen (Video)

- · The position of the screen is incorrect.
 - Check if the graphics card resolution and frequency are supported. If the frequency exceeds the supported range, use PC settings to set the resolution to the recommended value.
- · The screen flickers or shakes.
 - If you turn the monitor on when it is cold, the screen may flicker. This is normal.
 - Make sure that the current resolution and frequency settings of the graphics card are supported by the monitor.

Issues Related to the Screen (Color)

- · The screen resolution is low (16 colors).
 - Use PC settings to set the color to 24 bits (True Color) or above.
- · Black spots or bright spots appear on the screen.
 - Some pixels (red, green, blue, black) are visible on the screen due to the unique characteristics of the display panel. This is not a product malfunction.
- · The screen brightness looks dark.
 - Adjust the brightness and contrast.
 - The backlight needs to be repaired.

Issues Related to Sound

- · The audio doesn't work.
 - Check if the audio cable is connected properly.
 - Adjust the volume of the product or external device.
 - Check if the sound is set correctly.
- The sound is too low.
 - Adjust the volume of the product or external device.

Other Issues

- · The power suddenly turned off.
 - Check if the auto-off feature is on.
 - Power supply is interrupted. Check if the power cord is correctly plugged into the power outlet.
 - Check the power control settings.


Issues Related to Touch

- · Touch does not work.
 - Touch does not work when the product is turned off. Check the power of the product.
 - Failure to use a grounded socket may result in disconnection or touch errors. Make sure to connect the power cord to a grounded socket.
 - Check if the product screen is displayed.
 - Disconnection or touch errors may occur during touch input, as shown below.
 - When using the product only with your fingernails or fingertips
 - When holding the touch pen tip or holding the pen tip close to touch input
 - When inputting touch while pressing the touch pen with excessive force on the screen
- · The locations of the touch point and action point differ.
- This phenomenon occurs when the calibration of the touch screen is incorrect. Change the PC settings.
- · Multi-touch does not work.
 - Multi-touch may not be supported in the content being played (Flash Player, Paint, etc.). Use content that supports multi-touch.
 - Restart the content being played (Flash Player, Paint, etc.).
 - Try restarting the PC.
 - Multi-touch may be slightly unstable in the edge areas of the touch screen.
 - If the interval between two touches is too short, a touch error may occur.

Afterimage

- · After-image appears when the product is turned off.
 - Pixels may be damaged rapidly if a still image is displayed on the screen for a long period of time. Use the screen-saver function.
 - If a screen with colors with a large difference in luminance (black and white, grey) is output, an after-image may appear when the screen is switched to a dark screen. This is normal due to the display characteristics of this product.
- When the LCD screen is in a still pattern for extended periods of use, a slight voltage difference may occur between
 the electrodes that operate the liquid crystal (LC). The voltage difference between the electrodes increases over time
 and tends to keep the liquid crystal aligned in one direction. At this time, the previous image remains, which is called
 an afterimage.
- Afterimages do not occur when continuously changing images are used but take place when a certain screen is fixed
 for a long time. The following are operational recommendations for reducing the occurrence of afterimages when
 using a fixed screen. The maximum recommended time for switching the screen is 12 hours. Shorter cycles are better
 for preventing afterimages.
- · Recommended Usage Condition
 - 1 Change the background color and text color at equal intervals.
 - If the colors changed are complementary to each other, it is advantageous to prevent after-image.





ITO or MoTi Pixel Layer

- 2 Switch the screen at equal time intervals.
- Take caution, and ensure that text or images from before the screen change are not left in the same location after the screen change.
