INTRODUCTION



WARNING: The Anti-Tip feet must be installed before the display mount in order to prevent a tipping hazard.

- Installation order varies. You may have already installed and configured your C5 credenza using the C5 Series Credenza instruction sheet (I-00661). You may have also installed other available options purchased for your credenza. Regardless, you must now remove (and carefully set aside for re-installation) any installed equipment, items stored inside, wood sides, and the top surface of the credenza in order to properly attach the anti-tip feet as explained in the next topic.
- If your installation includes a DS-LSH1416-B FV Lockshelf 14x16 (I-00716) or DS-UTS10-B Utility Shelf (I-00719), they must be installed after this display mount assembly. If you already installed and configured either one, it must also be removed and set aside for re-installation when you reach the "Attaching the Mounting Sleeves to the Upright Columns" topic on page 11.

INSTALLING THE ANTI-TIP FEET



WARNING: The Anti-Tip feet must be installed before the display mount in order to prevent a tipping hazard.

1. As mentioned in the introduction, the installation order varies. If you already installed and configured your C5 credenza using the C5 Series Credenza instruction sheet (I-00661), you must now remove (and carefully set aside for re-installation) any installed equipment, items stored inside, wood sides, and the top surface.



2. With at least one additional person, carefully tip the frame over and gently place it upside-down onto an appropriate section of the floor to act as a work surface. (FIGURE A)



NOTE: Verify the torque on your power driver is on the lightest setting and only increase as necessary.


3. Use power driver, 5/16" socket, and (16x, 4x per rear foot) 10-32 x 3/8" thread forming screws (A) to attach (4x) rear anti-tip feet (B) to the locations on the frame as shown. (FIGURE B)

INSTALLING THE ANTI-TIP FEET (CONTINUED)

- Use driver, 5/16" socket and (4x) 10-32 x 3/8" thread forming screws (A) to attach (2x) front anti-tip feet (E) to the locations as shown. (FIGURE C)

NOTE:

- Caster removed from view for clarity.
- Anti-Tip feet and hardware shown in black on expanded view for clarity.



ATTACHING UPRIGHT COLUMN MOUNTING BRACKETS TO THE FRAME



WARNING: This procedure requires at least one additional person.



- With at least one additional person, carefully lift the frame and gently place it right-side up on the floor. (FIGURE D)

NOTE: Verify the torque on your power driver is on the lightest setting and only increase as necessary.

- Use power driver, 1/2" socket, and (2x) 5/16" hex head bolts (E), and (2x) 5/16" flange nuts (E) to attach the upright column mounting brackets (F) to your frame as shown.

- Install the wood sides on your frame by referring to the C5 Series Credenza instruction sheet (I-00661) at www.legrandav.com.



ATTACHING THE TOP AND DECORATIVE PLATES




WARNING: This procedure requires at least one additional person.

- Carefully team lift the top of your credenza and place it on top of the frame passing center holes on the back side of the top over the bolts on each upright column mounting bracket (F) as shown. (FIGURE E)

- Use the center holes on decorative plates (G) to place over the bolts on each upright column mounting bracket (H).



ATTACHING UPRIGHT COLUMNS TO COLUMN MOUNTING BRACKETS

1. Remove rear access panels from your credenza and carefully set them aside for re-installation. (FIGURE F)

2. Use 3/16" hex key (provided), (8x) 5/16-18 x 3" button head hex drive screws (H), and (8x) 5/16" washers (J) to attach the upright columns (K) as shown.




ATTACHING THE MOUNTING SLEEVES TO THE UPRIGHT COLUMNS

NOTE: When assembling 1/4-20 x 1/2" t-nut bolts (L) through the mounting sleeve locations specified in this topic and into 1/4-20 x 1/2" t-nuts (M), always position the inside flanges on the bolts toward the teeth side of the nuts. (FIGURE G)






1. Use your hand, (10x) 1/4-20 x 1/2" t-nut bolts (L) and (10x) 1/4-20 x 1/2" t-nuts (M) and loosely attach them (approximately 2 rotations each) in the following locations on the mounting sleeves (N) as shown. (FIGURE H)

2. Slide a mounting sleeve (N) onto the top of each upright column (K) by running the t-nuts (M, the ones loosely attached to the side flanges on the sleeves) into the column channels as shown. (FIGURE J)

3. Slide the sleeves down the length of the columns and gently set them on the decorative plates at the base of each upright.






ATTACHING THE MOUNTING SLEEVES TO THE UPRIGHT COLUMNS (CONTINUED)

4. Hold the starting end of a tape measure where the floor meets the lower back corner of the credenza.
5. Run the tape measure from the floor, along the back of the credenza, and up one of the columns (K).
6. Determine your desired center display height and then use a pencil to mark the location on the back corner of the upright as shown. (FIGURE K)




7. On the column you marked, slide the mounting sleeve up the column until your marking appears through the notch, then use a power driver and 3/8" socket to tighten (4x) 1/4-20 X 1/2" t-nut bolts (L) on the side flanges of the mounting sleeve (K) as shown. (FIGURE L)

ATTACHING TOP COVERS TO THE UPRIGHT COLUMNS

NOTE: Verify the torque on your power driver is on the lightest setting and only increase as necessary.

- Use 3/16" hex key (provided), (2x) upright column top covers (P), and (8x) 5/16-18 x 1/2" button head hex drive screws (R) to attach a cover on the top of both columns (K) as shown. (FIGURE M)


NOTE: Orient the top cover so the tabs are facing the rear as shown.



ATTACHING THE HORIZONTAL MOUNTING BRACKET TO THE MOUNTING SLEEVES

1. Attach the horizontal mounting bracket (S) onto the mounting sleeve (N, the one you fixed to your desired center display height on one of the upright columns, K) by sliding the grooves on the back over the teeth on the sleeves as shown. **(FIGURE N)**

NOTE: Along with the teeth, also slide the t-nut (M) on the lower corner of the front tab on the mounting sleeve (N) into the lower channel on the horizontal mounting bracket.



2. Slide the second mounting sleeve (N) up the column (K) to put the grooves on the horizontal mounting bracket (S) over the teeth on the second sleeve (N).


NOTE:

- Along with the teeth, also slide the t-nut (M) on the lower corner of the front tab on the second mounting sleeve (N) into the lower channel on the horizontal mounting bracket (S).
- Verify the torque on your power driver is on the lightest setting and only increase as necessary.

3. Place a level on the horizontal mounting bracket while using a power driver and 3/8" socket to tighten(4x) 1/4-20 X 1/2" t-nut bolts (L) on the side flanges of the second mounting sleeve (N).

4. Center the horizontal mounting bracket (S) on the bracket sleeves (N) as shown. **(FIGURE P)**


5. Use driver and and 3/8" socket to tighten each 1/4-20 X 1/2" t-nut bolt (L) on the lower corner front tab of each mounting sleeve (N) to lock the horizontal mounting bracket in place (S).



ATTACHING THE END CAPS TO THE HORIZONTAL MOUNTING BRACKET

NOTE: Verify the torque on your power driver is on the lightest setting and only increase as necessary.



- Use power driver, #2 Phillips bit, horizontal mounting bracket end caps (T) and (4x) ¼"-20 x ½" pan head screws (U) to attach an end cap onto each side of the horizontal mounting bracket (S) as shown. (FIGURE R)



SELECTING CORRECT INTERFACE BRACKET HARDWARE FOR YOUR DISPLAY

NOTE: The interface hardware kit provided includes different pan head screw sizes (I-A - I-M) to accommodate the threaded inserts on the back of most displays. This topic helps you select the correct size pan head screws for your display.

1. Use a toothpick or small straw as a thread depth indicator and insert it into a threaded insert on the back of your display.
2. With the toothpick or straw fully inserted, use a pencil to mark it at ⅛" above the surface as shown. (FIGURE S)



3. Select a pan head screw (I-A - I-M) that is shorter in length than the ⅛" mark you made on your thread depth indicator. (FIGURE T)



CAUTION: Only use screws shorter than the ⅛" mark or damage to the display may occur.

ATTACHING THE INTERFACE BRACKETS TO THE BACK OF YOUR DISPLAY

1. Carefully place your display facedown onto an appropriate work surface.

NOTE: Center the interface brackets on your display so they do not extend past the top or bottom.

2. Determine the correct size pan head screws (I-A - I-M) for attaching the interface brackets (V) to your display. For more information, see the previous topic.

ATTACHING THE INTERFACE BRACKETS TO THE BACK OF YOUR DISPLAY (CONTINUED)

3. Determine if spacers (I-N) are required when attaching the interface brackets to the back of your display. (FIGURE U)


WARNING: Spacers must be used if your display has a recessed and/or uneven portion on the back where the threaded inserts are located.

4. Use a power driver, #2 Phillips bit, (4x) spacers (I-N, if required), (4x) washers (I-P), and (4x) correct length pan head screws (I-A - I-M) to attach the brackets (V) to the back of your display as shown.




5. Open the latches on the bottom of each interface bracket (V) as shown. (FIGURE V)

HANGING YOUR DISPLAY ONTO THE HORIZONTAL MOUNTING BRACKET



1. With at least one other person, carefully lift your display slightly above the top edge of the horizontal mounting bracket (S).
(FIGURE W)

2. Slowly lower the display while ensuring top hooks on each interface bracket (V) are securely seated on the horizontal mounting bracket.

WARNING: Do not release your display until certain the top hook of each interface bracket is securely seated on the upper rail of the horizontal mounting bracket.

3. Center your display along the horizontal mounting bracket, and then carefully push along the bottom edge of your screen until the lower part of each interface bracket clicks into place.

CAUTION: Always maintain a very slight gap between inside edges when adjusting and securing dual displays (where applicable) along the bracket or screen and/or bezel damage may occur.

4. Close the latches on the bottom of each interface bracket.

5. Use 1/8" hex key (provided) and (2x) 10-24 x 5/8" button head hex drive screws (W) to secure the interface brackets in place along the horizontal mounting bracket as shown. **(FIGURE X)**

6. Use a lock (not provided) through the latch security holes on either interface bracket to secure your display to the structure, if desired. (FIGURE Y)



SECURING THE DISPLAY TILT ANGLE AND MANAGING YOUR CABLES

1. If necessary, use $\frac{1}{8}$ " hex key (provided) to carefully loosen the tilt friction bolt (use $\frac{1}{4}$ increments) on each interface bracket (V) as shown. (FIGURE Z)
2. Adjust your display to the desired tilt angle.
3. Use #2 Phillips screwdriver, 10-24 x $2\frac{1}{4}$ " Phillips screw (X), and 10-24 nut (Y) to lock each interface bracket to 20°, 10°, or 0° angles, if desired.



WARNING: If locking interface brackets, always set both to the same angle.







ATTACHING THE UPRIGHT COLUMN CABLE COVERS



1. While completing cable management for your display(s), leave enough slack to stow all wires into the groove along the upright columns (K) prior to attaching your cable upright column cable covers (AA).
2. Use power driver, #2 Phillips bit, and (8x) 10-32 x $\frac{3}{8}$ " truss head screws (AB), to attach a cable cover (AA) to the back of each upright column as shown. (**FIGURE AB**)
